IMPRTANT PERIOD

- Golden Hour - First 60 minutes
- Platinum Period - First 15 minutes
- Casualty stops breathing - 3 to 4 minutes available
- Bleeding - loss of 1.5 to 2 ltrs of blood can be critical



CPR

Use CPR when an adult is not breathing or when they are only gasping occasionally, and when they are not responding to questions or taps on the shoulder. In children and infants, use CPR when they are not breathing normally and not responding. Check that the area is safe, then perform the following steps.



1st Step

Call 108 or ask someone for help



3rd Step

Check breathing. If person not breathing, start CPR



5th Step

Perform 15 Chest compressions



2nd Step

Lay the person on their back and open their airway.



4th Step

Give 2 rescue breaths



6th Step

Repeat rescue breaths and chest compressions till an ambulance arrives.
